




Programming



Welcome to Summer Camp 2023!

We are so happy to have you as part of our community this year! This newsletter will give you insight into your camper's day and provide you with helpful tips to keep summer moving smoothly. We even included a section of questions to ask your camper to get them to start talking to you about their day. Please reach out to us at any time with questions you may have and thank you for entrusting us with your children this week.

JUST MOVE: CATCH THE FALLING CONES!

Focus, hand eye coordination, and positioning are all important in this activity. Campers will spread out in a defined area and create a circle around the leader. The leader will randomly throw or fling cones around the play area and campers try to catch as many as they can. Games like these foster competition and communication as well as work on spatial awareness. Campers can be shown and taught that they won't always win everything, but they can always do their best. This is also a great opportunity to foster an attitude of joy towards their fellow campers. Feeling genuinely excited for someone else to win a game is a hard skill to master and teaching campers early is a great

EULDING STRONG CAMPERS COMPASSION

We love seeing our campers show a desire to help and and show concern for someone in need. This week start a discussion with your child about how they can help others. Teaching children compassion is a vital part of their childhood journey – and a skill that will help them throughout their life. "Through learning the importance of compassion, children will learn how to be kind to themselves, others and help those in need. As part of a broader skill set, compassion will help them think creatively in situations, make decisions that inspire their personal journey, and pursue life with purpose." (wildkindplayschool.com) Building compassion in your child will help them find sense of belonging, trust, and friendship in their camp group.

SAFETY REMINDER: HYDRATION

Your child spends time at summer camp outdoors and in strenuous activity. It is important for you to encourage them to drink water often and remind them to take water breaks during activities. "A study in the American Journal of Public Health found that nearly 55% of participants ages 6 to 19 are inadequately hydrated. As a rule of thumb, children ages 4 to 8 should drink 7.5 cups of fluid a day and children ages 9 to 12 should drink 10 cups. Remind your child to avoid sugary drinks, sports drinks, and caffeine." (activekids.com) A helpful tool to keep this easy for your child? Pack a refillable water bottle each day so it can be easily refilled during and after outdoor activities.

ASK ME ABOUT: NEW INTERESTS

During the first week of camp, your child is experiencing fun activities and making new friends. This week, take time to ask your child about what new things they have learned at camp and what they are excited to explore during camp. This is a great way to learn about new interests your child may be forming and for you to have a window into their camp experience. This will also help to open future conversations on developing skills and talents and forming new friendships.






