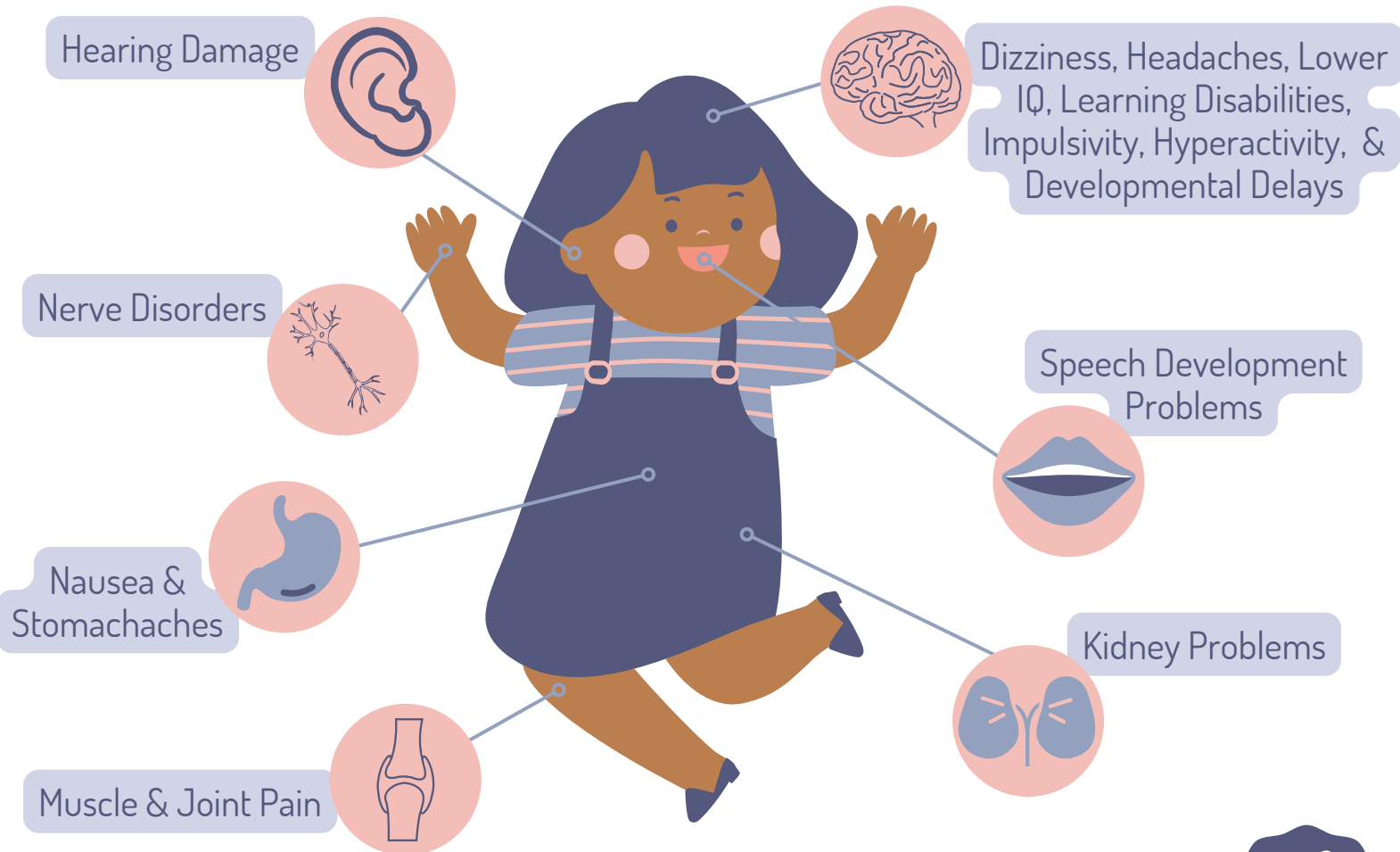

Facts About Lead Poisoning



The effects of lead poisoning may not appear until your child is older.

The effects of lead poisoning are permanent. It cannot be cured or reversed.

It is important to test your child at least twice before age 3 for lead; your child's doctor may recommend more testing as needed.

Prevention is the best way to ensure your child's health will not be effected by lead poisoning.
